

Imperial County Community Benefit Program Letter of Interest Requirements

Pursuant the Guidelines for the Imperial County Community Benefit Program, potential applicants are required to first submit a Letter of Interest to the Community Benefit Advisory Committee. Those Letters will be reviewed by the Committee and eligible projects will then be requested to submit a full Application for potential funding under the Program.

The Letter of Interest must contain the following information:

- 1. Name of Organization
- 2. Name and Contact Information for primary point of contact
- 3. Description of Project
- 4. Requested Funding Amount and Project Budget
- 5. Project Funding Category (see Guidelines)
- 6. Proposed Timeline for Completion of Proposed Project
