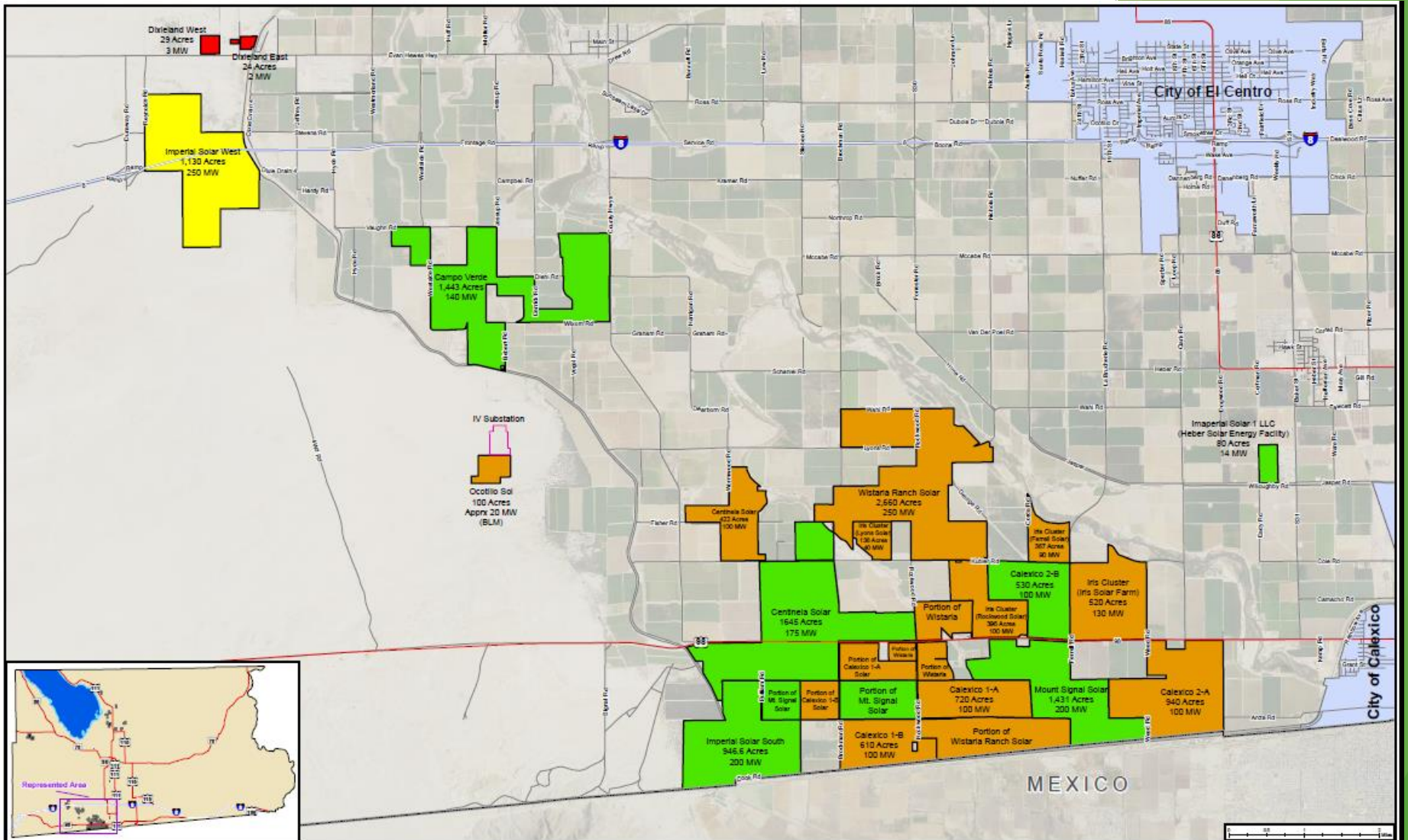

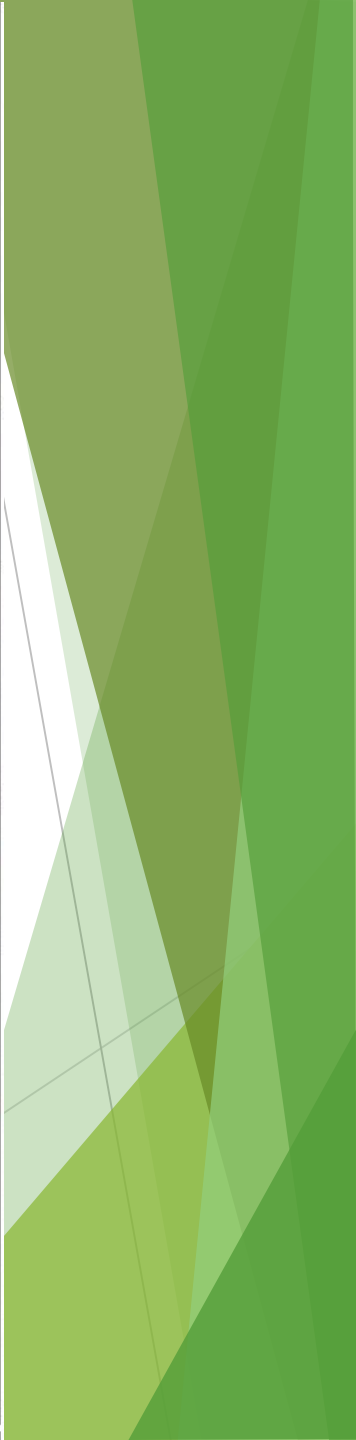
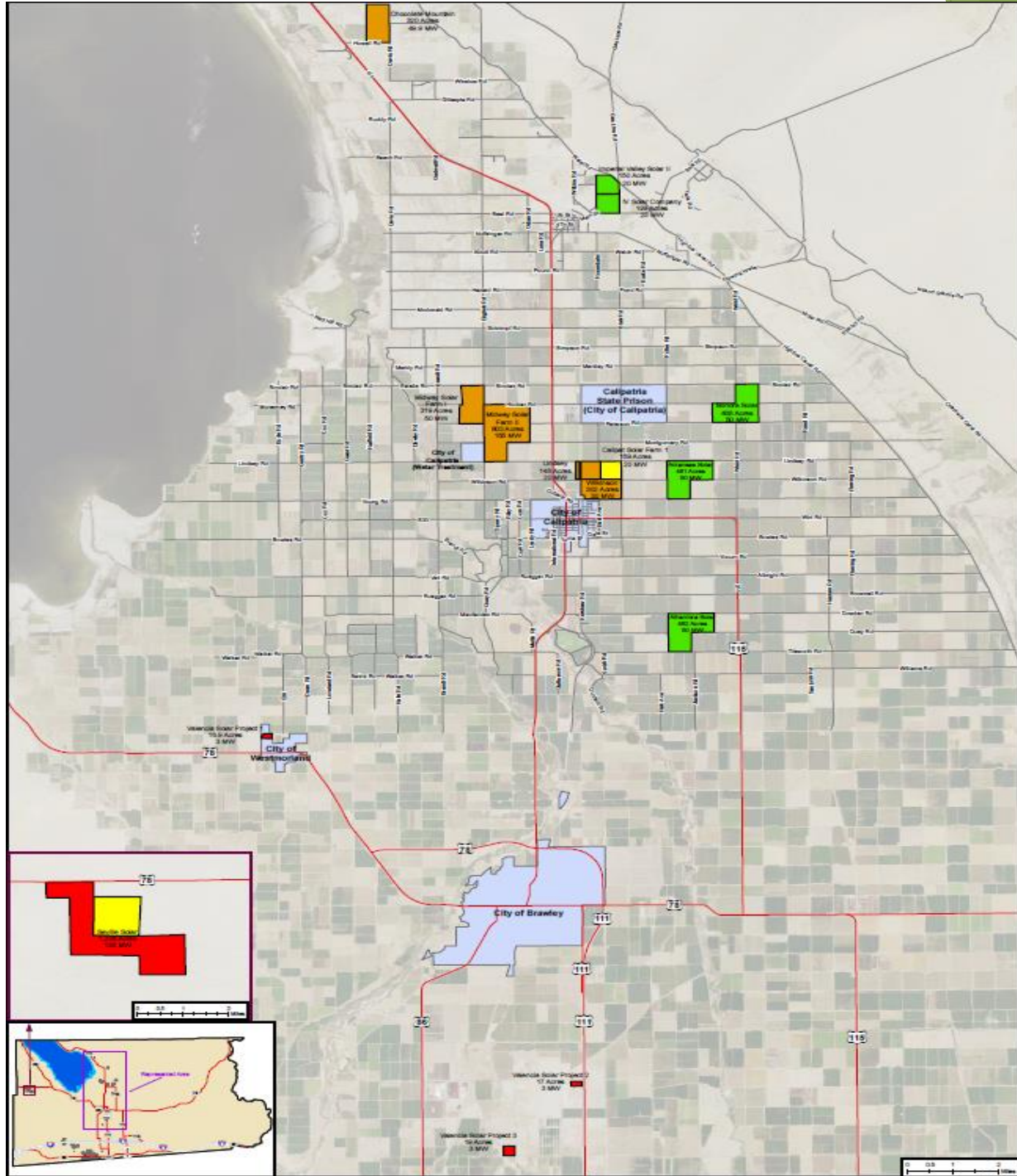
# Imperial County Solar Farm Projects South End Projects

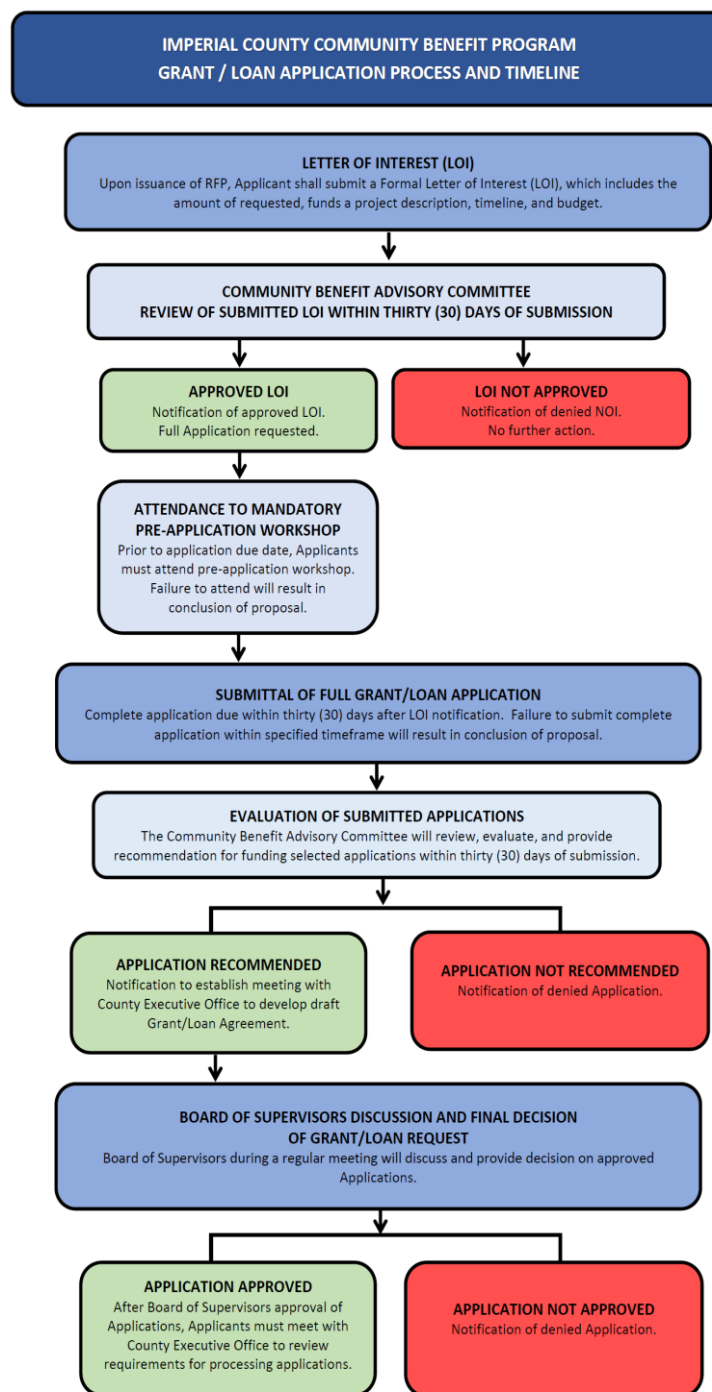
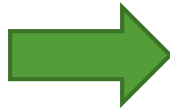

7. VALID AGENCY AND/OR NON-PROFIT (501C3) DOCUMENTATION
8. FEDERAL W-9 FORM
9. RESOLUTION OF BOARD'S/COUNCIL'S ACCEPTANCE OF FUNDS

### AFTER GRANT IS APPROVED

10. WRITTEN ITEMIZATION OF EXPENDITURES
11. PROOF OF PAYMENT FOR PURCHASES MADE AS PART OF PROGRAM
12. DOCUMENTATION OF USE OF MATCHING FUNDS
13. ELECTRONIC PHOTOS OF PURCHASES/PROJECT
