COUNTY OF IMPERIAL POSTCARD DESIGN CONTEST

Imperial County has some of the most beautiful landscapes and treasures in California and the United States. Some may be well known highlights of the county's natural beauty, such as the Colorado River, Mount Signal, the Imperial Sand Dunes, the Salton Sea, and Imperial Valley's emerald farm fields. Yet, there are likely other beauties that capture the essence of Imperial County and its greatest resource, its people and traditions.

Postcards are one of the most meaningful and affordable ways of sending a message to those near and far. Postcards are also a great tool to inspire and promote a place, activity, or adventure. The County of Imperial is looking for images/visuals of our community and the people who live within it that conveys the assets, individuality, history, and splendor of our community to travelers far and wide.

As a result, the County of Imperial is holding an Imperial County Postcard Design Contest. This is an opportunity to create a lasting symbol for the county. The contest is open to all.

OFFICIAL CONTEST RULES:

- Only one entry/design per person. Each entry MUST be accompanied with the entry submission form.
- Must reside in Imperial County.
- Entry may be submitted in any art medium with a minimum size of 4.25" x 6" or 1275px x 1800px. If an entry is not submitted in a digital format, artists must realize that the winning design has to be turned into a digital picture in order to create a postcard; therefore, designs might be slightly altered in the process.
- Design may include the County Logo or County Seal. Including these elements are optional.
- By submitting an entry, entrant hereby grants permission for the entry to be posted on the County website, social media platforms, and used in press materials.
- The top three winning entries will become the property of the County of Imperial and may be reproduced for distribution.

CONTEST TIMELINE:

- Deadline for submissions: May 15, 2023.
- Entry Forms will be available on the County of Imperial website: www.imperialcounty.org, beginning April 1, 2023. Submission information will be on the entry form.
- At least five finalists will be posted for public voting from May 22, 2023 at 12pm to June 5, 2023 at 12pm.
- Of the finalists, the top three winning entries will be selected by the Imperial County Board of Supervisors.

PRIZES:

- The top three winning entries will then be awarded prizes of \$750 for first place, \$500 for second and \$250 for third.
- Any school-aged students entering the contest will receive a Certificate of Participation from the Board of Supervisors.
